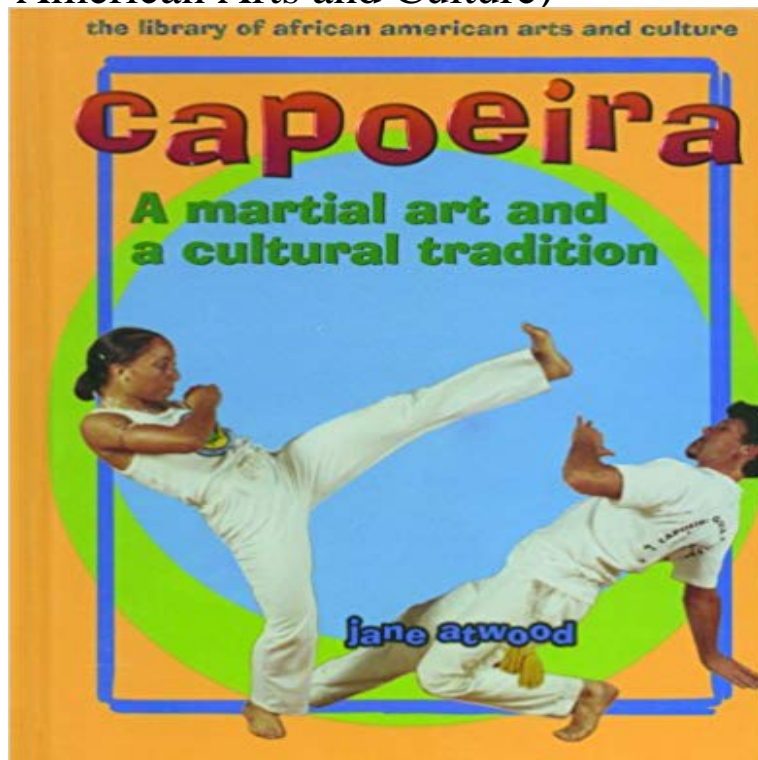


Capoeira: A Martial Art and a Cultural Tradition (Library of African American Arts and Culture)
