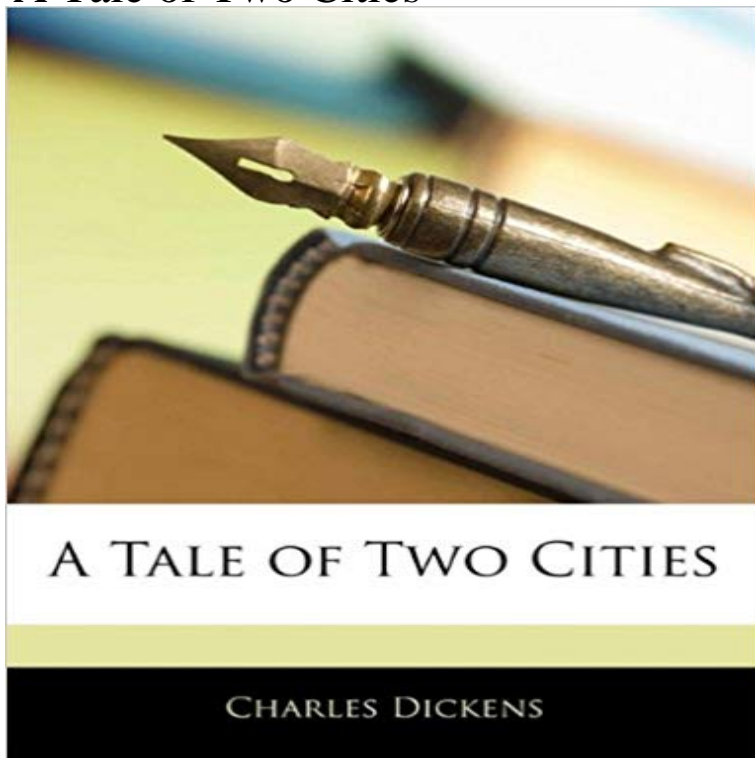


A Tale of Two Cities
