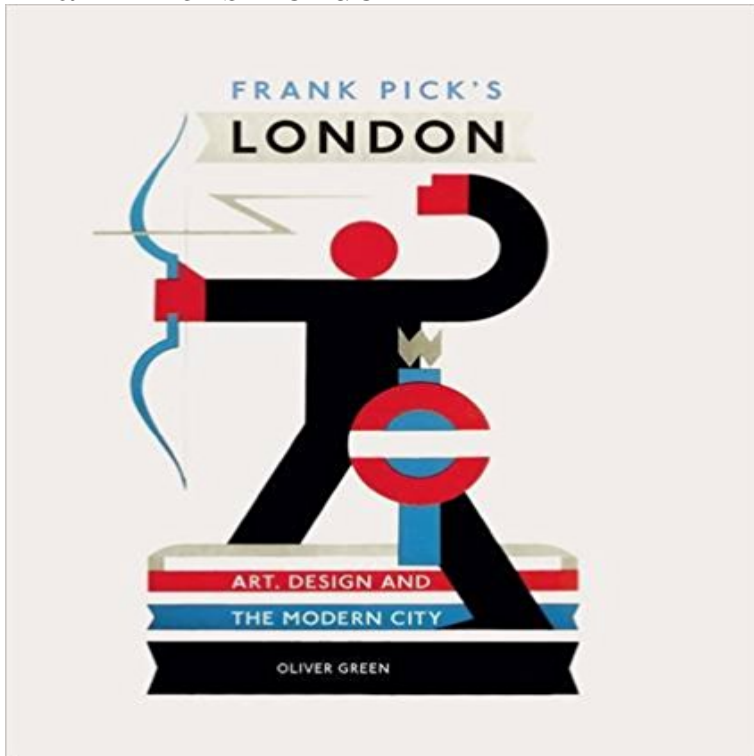


## Frank Picks London
