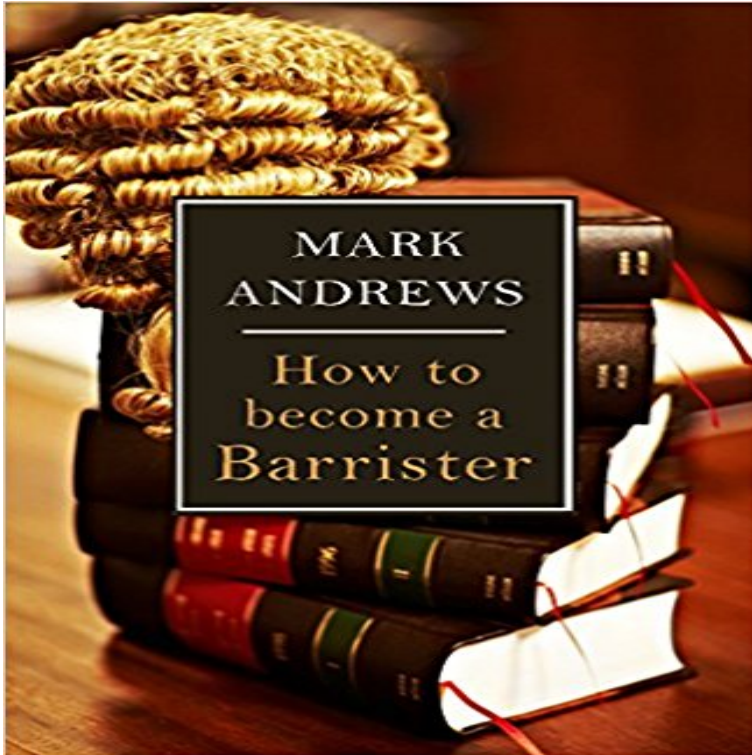


How To Become A Barrister
