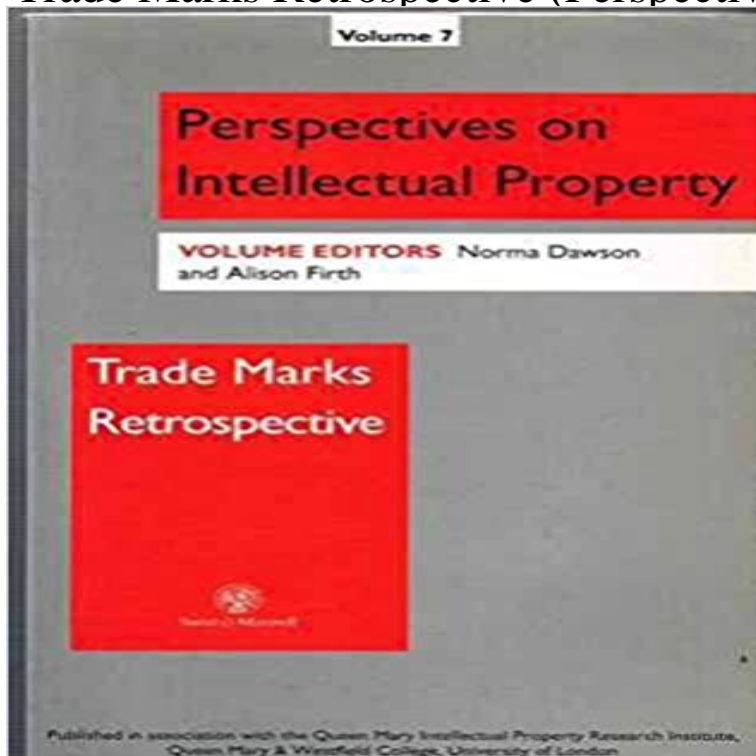


## Trade Marks Retrospective (Perspectives on Intellectual Property Law)
