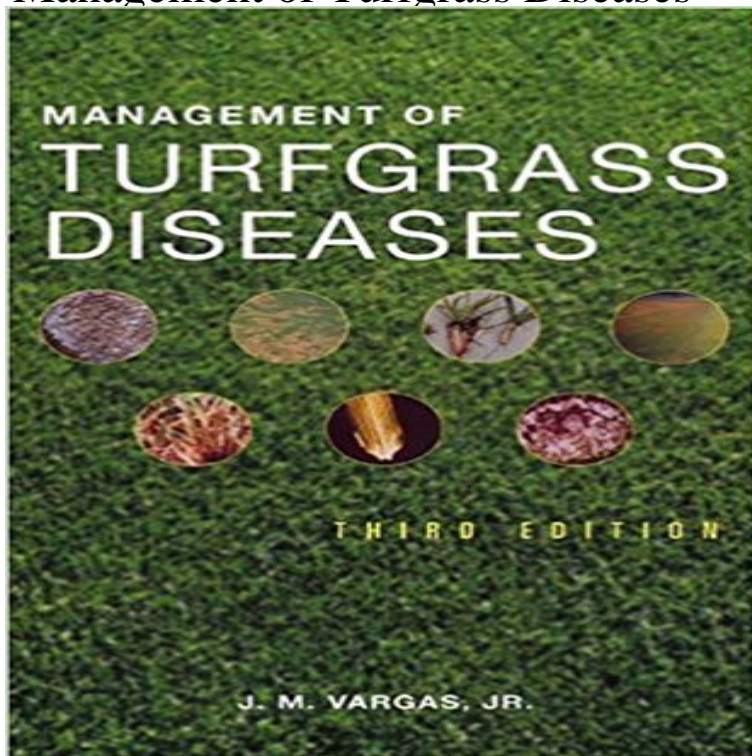


Management of Turfgrass Diseases
